Complication sessions will provide you with the best educative experience in order to learn tips and tricks on how to avoid and resolve difficult situations.

Practical educative "Non Invasive Imaging Techniques" sessions will complete this extensive programme.

AsiaPCR/SingLIVE is based on the concept – "Together we achieve more".
